DISTRICT AUDITING SERVICES

The Board unanimously approved renewal of the auditing services agreement with Schowalter & Jabouri, PC through June 2013.

TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT & EVALUATION

The Board unanimously approved the transportation program evaluation and contract with First Student, Inc. with a rate freeze for FY2010-2011 and an extension of one year of contract to FY2013-2014.

FOOD SERVICES CONTRACT

The Board unanimously approved renewal of the food service contract with Chartwells through June 2011 for a total cost of approximately \$1.25M and meal prices to be \$1.58 for breakfast, \$2.01 for lunch and \$1.02 for snacks.

BRITTANY LIBRARY FURNITURE

The Board unanimously approved the purchase of furniture for the Brittany Woods Library / Media Center from the lowest bidder, School Specialty, in the amount of \$59,971.67.

FLYNN PARK PTO PLAYGROUND DONATION

The Board unanimously approved the acceptance of \$33,000 donation in cash and pledges to be used as part of the Municipal Park Grant to build a new playground in Flynn Park.

REAL TALK, INC.

Sultan Muhammad and Victor Pichon of Real Talk, Inc. gave an update on the gang-prevention program at Brittany Woods and University City High School.

UCFT MEET & CONFER

The Board unanimously approved the 2010-2011 Meet and Confer agreement with the University City Federation of Teachers SRP Local #3179.
