KIDS PLACE

The Board unanimously approved after-school transportation during SY2011-2012 for students in neighborhoods near Delmar-Harvard, who are enrolled and participating in the Kid's Place after-school program.

JACKSON PARK ADDITION

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

MATH TEXTBOOK - GRADES 7-12
