2 boxes of crayons (8 or 16 ONLY), regular size
1 package of paper napkins
1 package of paper plates
2 boxes of Kleenex

Snack: Please send a non-perishable snack to school with your child to share with the class during the first month of school. The snack should be big enough to serve 25 children. Drinks are also welcome; single-serving drink boxes are preferred. Monthly snack calendars will begin in mid-Sept.
