Program Accessibility Standards

In accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, the District will ensure that its programs and activities are readily accessible to and usable by physically handicapped students, staff, parents/guardians and community patrons.

Federal legislation does not require the District to make each facility or every part of a facility physically accessible to and usable by handicapped persons. Whenever financially and structurally possible, the District will redesign or alter facilities to provide access and use to all. Any building alteration completed shall comply with applicable Uniform Federal Accessibility Standards and American Disability Act Accessibility Guidelines for Buildings and Facilities.

Where structural facility renovation is impossible, ADA compliance will be accomplished by approved alternate means, including but not limited to reassignment of services or programs to accessible sites, development of alternate program delivery systems, or any method which results in handicapped patrons receiving equal services as non-handicapped patrons. In choosing among available methods for meeting program accessibility requirements, the District shall give priority to the options that serve handicapped persons in the most appropriate integrated setting.
