Admission and Withdrawal

Admission and Tuition - Nonresident Employees' Children

WHEREAS, HB 628 was passed by the General Assembly and signed by Governor Mel Carnahan on July 7, 1997;

WHEREAS, HB 628 became law on August 28, 1997;

WHEREAS, the Board of Education believes it is in the best interest of its employees and their children to attend District schools;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby approves and permits children of any regular employee who does not live in the District to attend University City schools and be counted as resident students without the payment of tuition.

This policy is limited to children only of regular District employees and full time employees of Special School District, who are assigned to perform their duties at the District. Effective January 10, 2008, grandchildren or other minor relatives of such employees will not be permitted to newly enroll in the District as residents under this policy. However, students currently enrolled in the District who are grandchildren or other minor relatives of regular District employees shall be permitted to continue their enrollment in the District. Students who meet other criteria for enrollment under Missouri law, as set forth in Regulation 2240, are not affected by the limitations of this policy.
