Competitive Food Sales

In order to comply with requirements of the Part 210, National School Lunch Program and Part 220, School Breakfast Program as amended, regarding the sale of food in competition with meals served under the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program, the sale of categories of foods of minimal nutritional value from the beginning of the school day to the end of the last lunch period is prohibited. The restricted categories of foods are identified as carbonated beverages, water ices, chewing gum and certain candies (hard candies, jellies and gums, marshmallow candies, fondants, licorice, spun candies and candy coated popcorn).
