I am following up from my email to you yesterday with promised new resources and a few new updates:

- The District has created a [Question and Answer](#) document regarding the start of the 2020-21 school year. We will be adding to it further, but we are confident that this document will answer many of your questions.
- As requested, I am also sharing with you sample schedules for both our [Brick Academy](#) and [Click Academy](#) options. These will give you an idea of the flow and structure of an academic day in both options. It also includes what a fully virtual day will look like in Brick Academy. As a reminder, parents are asked to begin the enrollment process for Click Academy for their child by this Saturday, August 1. Families who fill out the enrollment form will be sent an email this weekend inviting them to attend a Click Academy Town Hall on Monday, August 3 at 9 a.m. or 5 p.m. I encourage you to attend.
- Parents with children receiving services from the Special School District of St. Louis County (SSD), please keep an eye out for an email invitation from DeAndria Player, director of SSD for U. City Schools, inviting you to a SSD Zoom meeting this Friday, July 31 at 2 p.m. This session is intended for you to ask direct questions to our SSD staff.
- Our first Parent Café sessions yesterday on parent and child-well being during a global pandemic was a huge success and full of very powerful information. Our next Parent Café sessions are next Tuesday, August 4 at 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. The Café is titled “From Brick to Click” and will focus on Brick Academy.
