Dear University City High School Families:

I have news for you about our fall UCHS athletic calendar.

On August 13, The Missouri State High School Activities Association (MSHSAA) board took action to allow for the scheduling of alternative fall and spring seasons for schools unable to participate in the traditional fall sports season.

Given the MSHSAA action, the District has decided to move our fall competition opportunities to the late winter and spring of 2021 under a plan put forward by the Suburban Alternative Fall Committee. Dates for the start of practices and games will be shared soon.

University City High School athletes participating in all fall sports (girls tennis, girls softball, girls field hockey, girls volleyball, cheer squad, girls cross country, co-ed cross country, boys cross country, co-ed dance, boys swimming, boys football and boys soccer) are encouraged to participate in fall conditioning sessions. Schedules for the conditioning sessions will be forthcoming from the athletic department.

Athletics are an important part of our community, and we need to be safe, gradual and kind with our re-entry into the school year during a global pandemic. I understand that this year is very different from what we have experienced in the past. We will continue to work closely with our local and national experts to ensure the safety and well-being of our students. We hope to provide our students with as many opportunities as possible when it is safe to do so.
