Dear U. City Families:

I hope you are well. This is just a brief update to remind all families that our new Grab & Go meal schedule begins tomorrow, Tuesday, April 7.

Additionally, please join me at one of two virtual Zoom sessions this Wednesday, April 8 at 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. The hour-long virtual meetings will give you a chance to provide feedback on distance learning and ask any questions. To register to receive links to join the meetings and instructions, go to www.ucityschools.org/Zoom.

Here are the key points for the changes to the Grab & Go meal program:

- Today, Monday, there will be no meal pickups nor porch deliveries. All Grab & Go locations are closed.
- Curbside pickups will now be held only on Tuesdays and Fridays from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. for enhanced efficiency and safety.
- Students will now be provided breakfasts, lunches and dinners to last them to the next pickup day. They will be getting the equivalent of three meals a day, seven days a week if you go to both the Tuesday and Friday pickups.
- Porch deliveries will continue for families unable to come to a pickup location.
- Flynn Park is no longer a pickup site. Flynn Park families may go to any of the other Grab & Go sites located at Barbara C. Jordan, Jackson Park, Pershing and Brittany Woods.
