After graduating,

he furthered his studies at the Universitat Mozarteum in Salzburg, Austria. In 1985, Ford received a two-year Fulbright Scholarship in order to continue his studies abroad. Ford became the first African American to accept a professorship as a member of Pedagogy Faculty for Piano at the Mozarteum, a position he holds currently. In addition to performing concerts, teaching, and conducting workshops in the United States, Europe and Asia, Ford is pursuing a doctoral degree in Musicology.
