The late Louis M. Leipziger worked from the age of six to help support his

family. One day, while selling newspapers, Julius Baer bought a paper from Leipziger and told him that if he ever needed a job, he could come work for Stix, Baer & Fuller.

After graduating from University City High School, Leipziger took Baer up on his offer. He began his career as a stockboy where he made \$14 a week. Through the years, he worked his way up the corporate ladder and became president in 1973. He was the first man to hold this position who was not a member of the Baer family. He retired three years later after 46 years in the business.

Leipziger died in January 1997.
