## **Dr. David A. Lieberman**

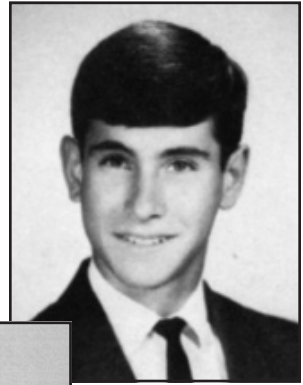

David Lieberman, son of former University City councilmember Larry Lieberman and former University City school board member Joy Lieberman, graduated from University City High School in 1968 and proceeded to earn his degrees through doctorate of medicine from the University of Michigan in 1976.

Recognized internationally as an expert in colon cancer screening, he is now a professor of medicine and chief of the division

of Gastroenterology at Oregon Health Sciences University in Portland, Oregon, and Portland Veterans' Administration Medical Center, chairman of the Multi-Social Task Force on Colon Cancer Screening and serves as secretary general for International Digestive Cancers Alliance. He is the former president of the American Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (including involvement since 1992) and a member of the National Commission on Digestive Diseases. He has received the Cancer Research and Prevention Foundation Laurel for Leaders and the Rudolph Schindler Award for lifetime achievement and has been inducted into the Association of American Physicians.

Lieberman has overseen more than \$8.75M in grant funding and has published more than 165 articles and 100 chapters on varying medical issues.
