the United States and Canada, as well as the Caribbean, Europe, Asia, and Australia.

Zuckerman served as president of the North American Concert Promotions Association in 1992-94. Recently, he and Schankman were awarded Ernst & Young's "Entrepreneur of the Year" award for Communications and Entertainment. In 1997, Contemporary became part of SFX, now owned by Clear Channel Communications, a company that operates 900 radios stations (plus 240 abroad), 19 television stations, and more than 700,000 outdoor advertising displays across the world. Zuckerman is currently co-CEO of the SFX Music Group, the world's largest live entertainment company.
